Christmas Plays Junior Infants performed Rudolph the Reindeer play for their families.

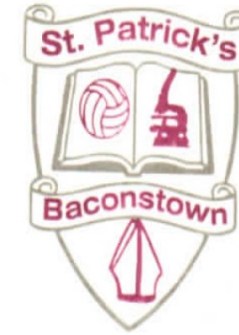
